The Family Resource Center

Since our founding in 1991, our agency has proudly served Rome and Floyd County by partnering with community, regional, and state leadership to bring family-centered and strength-building child abuse prevention programs to our community. As a fully accredited agency, we provide in-home services using the evidence-based Exchange Parent Aide model as well as a variety of parent education courses. We continue to be part of a 67-member collaborative of child abuse prevention agencies nationwide that use the Exchange Parent Aide model. In 2022 thanks to the Promoting Safe and Stable Families Grant, we were able to extend our Exchange Parent Aide services to four families in Polk county.

We provide transformative in-home education and support to Floyd and Polk County families, empowering them to create safe, stable, and nurturing homes so that their children can grow and thrive.



The Population We Serve Recipients of Parent Aide Services


- 6% of the primary caregivers are grandparents or other relatives.
